- Build Teacher capacity to consistently implement Essential Skills for Classroom Management.
- Engage Internal and External Positive Behaviour for Learning Coaches.
- Provide focused and intensive teaching targeted at 'C' students in order to improve the quality of their demonstrations of learning against the relevant year-level achievement standard.
- Develop Teacher capability with respect to designing curriculum-aligned monitoring tasks.
- Implement programs to support the early phase Literacy and Numeracy, including the schedule of Early Start assessments, opportunities for professional conversations regarding student progress and strategies for intervention.
- Strengthen the case management approach for Secondary students through targeted attainment and transition programs.
