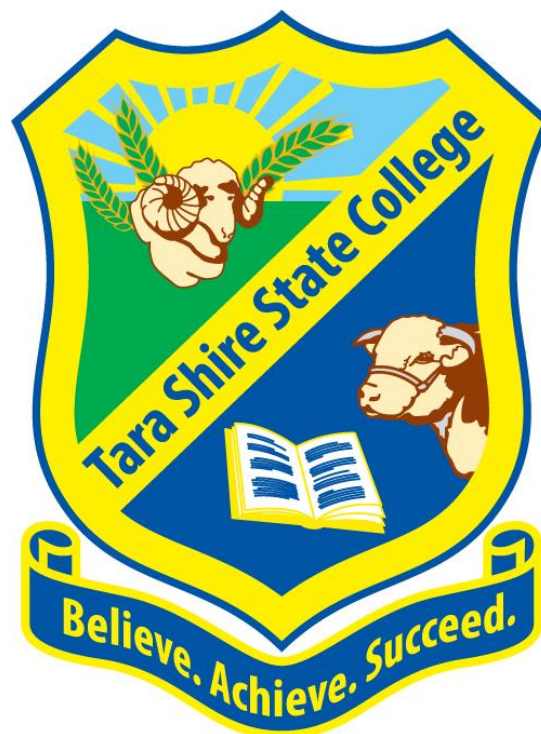

Health and Physical Education and School Sport is an important part of the Tara Shire State College curriculum and enrichment programs. The college works hard to ensure there is a positive culture and pathways for students to take an active role in in Physical Education and School Sport.

Health & Physical Education Curriculum

The Australian Curriculum and Queensland Curriculum and Assessment Authority subjects/work programs are implemented across the entire college. Physical Education teachers and class teachers are required to implement the curriculum as outlined by the ACARA, QCAA and State Schooling. This is an overview of the focus areas in the three learning junctures of the college. Teachers will also teach unit of works leading up to the annual sports carnivals.

Tara SSC Athlete Development Program

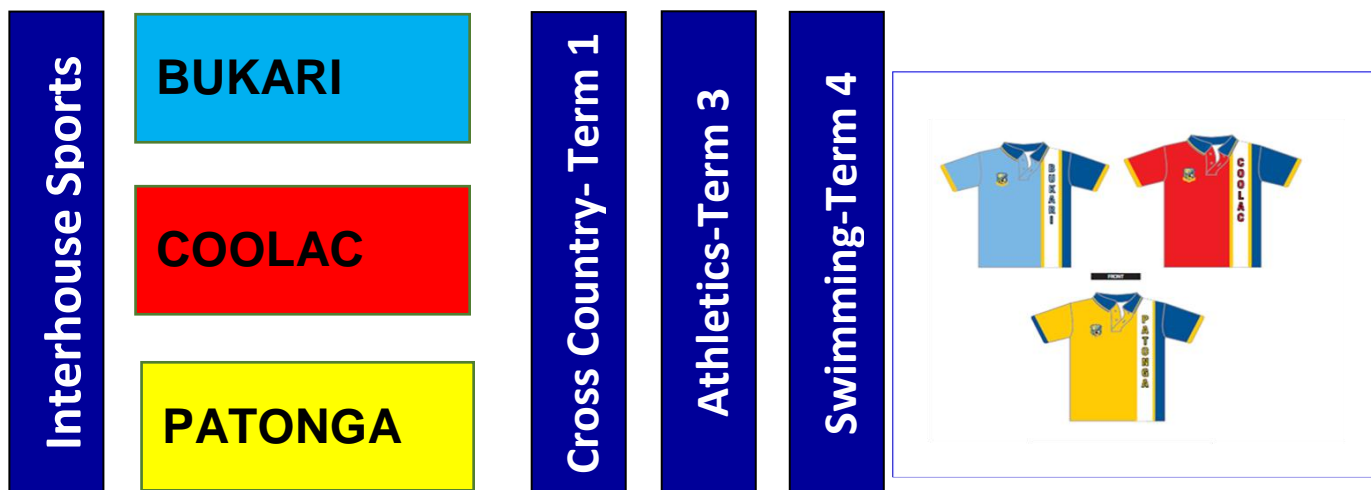
The Tara Athlete Development Program-TAD is an innovative program which caters for gifted students 10-15 years old across all sporting disciplines. The program aims to develop young sportspeople in terms of their:

- sporting skills
- fitness
- enthusiasm towards sport and school
- academic work, through sport
- sportsmanship and school citizenship

The program will be limited to number of students per group. There will be two groups 10-12 year olds and 13-15 year olds.

Interhouse Sports

Tara Shire State College has three sports houses, Bukari, Coolac and Patonga. There is a strong sense tradition and competition between the houses. On enrolment students are placed in one of three College Sports Houses. There is no guarantee that siblings will be placed in the same house. This is due to balancing house numbers, age groups and genders across the three houses. Age Champions will be awarded to 9 year olds and above for both females and males for the three Interhouse Carnivals.

Swimming (2016)

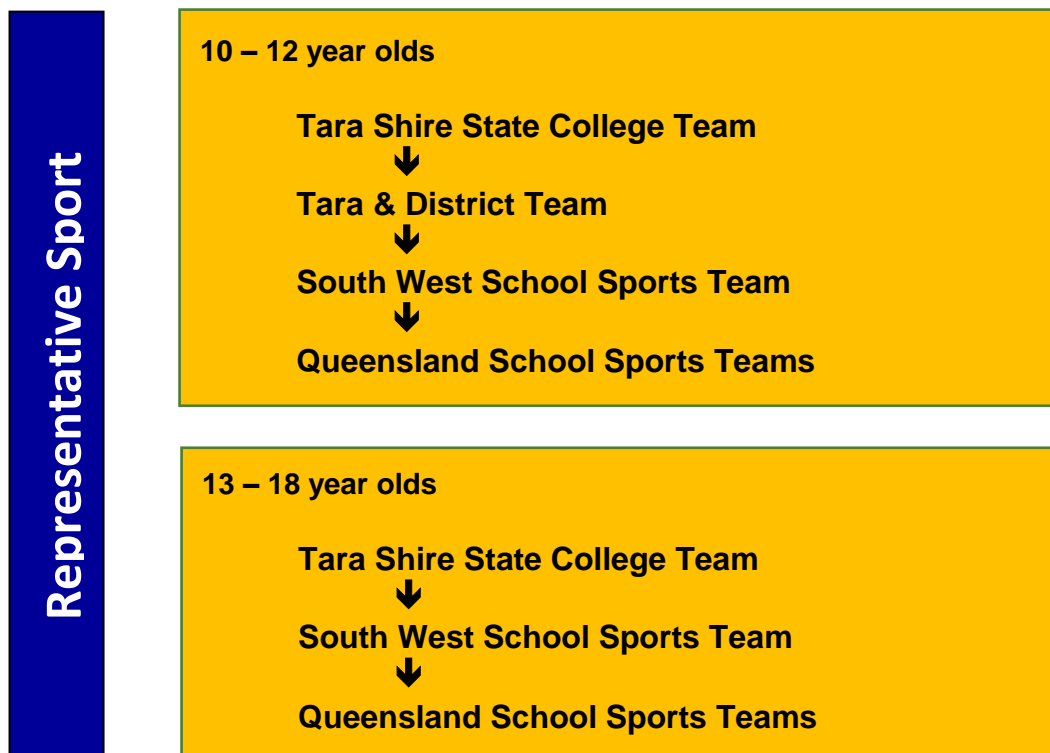

For all South West and Queensland Teams, team officials will be appointed through a selection process. The officials that are appointed will be qualified in the sport they are selected for. This is often a very competitive process within the region and state.
