This funding will be used to


- Increase the percentage of students achieving an A-C rating in English, Mathematics and Science to 80% across the college (Prep-12)
- Implement intervention programs for students below benchmark in reading performance (focus Prep-2)
- Procure additional human resources to support teaching staff knowledge and understanding, student services programs and student learning programs through a student services model.
- Provide targeted professional development and coaching to deepen teachers' understandings of the Australian Curriculum
- Support teachers in collaborative inquiry model to deliver quality outcomes for students (Instructional coaching)
- Increase Student Attendance to 90% across the college

Our initiatives include

- Strengthening teacher understanding and knowledge of the Australian Curriculum through collaborative inquiry process focused on instructional coaching.
- Provide Teacher Relief Scheme (TRS) to enable triads of teachers/leaders to engage in collaborative data inquiry, action learning, classroom visits and professional conversations Pedagogy on Demand (PODS)
- Establish a consistent approach to the teaching of reading in the early years (Prep – Year 2) aligned to the Literacy continua.
- Establish a student portfolio system to track and monitor academic achievement in English, Mathematics and Science across the college (Prep-12)
- Strengthen senior student case management approach for students who are completing Year 11 and 12.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Employment of: \$258 836
 - Secondary Deputy Principal (0.15 Full Time Equivalent (FTE -Workplace Reform)
 - Head of Curriculum (0.2 FTE-Workplace Reform)
 - Extra Teachers (FTE 1.00)
 - Support Teacher: Literacy & Numeracy allocation (0.5 FTE)
 - Speech Language Pathologist allocation (0.4 FTE)
 - External Coach-Positive Behaviour for Learning (0.15 FTE)
- Engaging in targeted professional development for teachers and teacher aides \$10 000
